Community Assessment Services Center (CASC)

AN OVERVIEW

The Community Assessment Services Center (CASC) provides free and confidential substance abuse screenings, assessments and referrals to treatment, as well as mental health & domestic violence referrals for Los Angeles County's CalWORKs, General Relief (GR), Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) and community clients in the San Fernando Valley, Santa Clarita and Palmdale areas.

The CASC works in coordination with the Los Angeles County Department of Social Services (DPSS), Alcohol and Drug Program Administration (ADPA) and the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to provide referrals to appropriate treatment agencies.

Left undiagnosed and untreated, substance abuse, mental health and domestic violence problems can create devastating barriers to self-sufficiency. The CASC is designed to help participants overcome these barriers and obtain the services they need so they may become productive members of the work force and the community.

CASC Services

- ◆ Provides, face-to-face, comprehensive substance abuse screenings and assessments, in both English and Spanish, for GR, CalWORKs and DCFS participants and then provides the appropriate referrals to local treatment providers.
- ◆ Acts as a resource and provides substance abuse, mental health, domestic violence and other supportive service referrals for community clients.
- ◆ Acts as a conduit between the county and community-based providers for information concerning CalWORKs, GR, Prop. 36 and DCFS issues, policies, procedures and concerns.
- ◆ Provides outreach services for participants at DPSS, GAIN, Job Club and other supportive service offices to inform participants about supportive service benefits, especially in the areas of substance abuse, domestic violence and mental health.
- ◆ Initial screening conducted both in-person and by phone.

FEES

CASC services are free to CalWORKs, GR, and DCFS participants, and other community residents.

FUNDING

Funds are provided in whole or in part by the County of Los Angeles through the Alcohol and Drug Program Administration, DCFS and Department of Social Services. Funds are also provided by the State of California.

REFERRALS

Referrals include, but are not limited to, public social services, housing, health, legal and mental health agencies. Referrals are given to county funded or private substance abuse and mental health providers primarily within the CASC's geographical area of responsibility.
