Mission

The North Valley Youth and Family Center's mission is to provide outpatient mental health services to meet the needs of emotionally disturbed children and adolescents. The goal is to enable youth to remain in their current home and school environments while developing coping skills, a positive sense of self-worth, and an enriched quality of life.

Who Seeks Help from North Valley Youth and Family Center?

Families with a child or adolescent with an emotional or behavioral problems may receive care in this program.

What Services Are Provided By North Valley Youth and Family Center?

The Center offers a variety of outpatient services. Depending upon the needs of the child, types of services provided and duration may vary. Available services include:

- ◆ Clinical Assessment
- ◆ Crisis Intervention
- ◆ Individual and Group Therapy
- ◆ Family Therapy
- ◆ Psychoeducational Groups



- ◆ Substance Abuse Prevention
- ◆ Medication Evaluation and Support
- ◆ Rehabilitation Services
- ◆ Parenting Groups
- ◆ Case Management Services

How North Valley Youth and Family Center Can Help

Youth in this program receive help in developing coping skills, reducing symptoms, and achieving a positive attitude of self-worth. Families are helped with their interactions and are included as full partners in their child's therapeutic care. While receiving treatment, children are able to remain in their home and school environments.

Fees

Services are provided to clients with Medi-Cal, Healthy Families Insurance, and under the AB3632 Program Funding.

Referral Procedures

Referrals are accepted from: L.A. County Departments of Mental Health; Child and Family Services, Probation, schools, hospitals, community centers, private providers, and self-referrals.

Funding

Funds are provided in whole or in part by the County of Los Angeles through the Department of Mental Health.

Intakes

At the request of a parent or guardian, intakes are scheduled during program hours. For crisis situations and post-hospital care, intakes are completed within 72 hours of application whenever possible.

Cost

Costs are covered by Medi-Cal under EPSDT funding, by Healthy Families Insurance or under the AB3632 Program Funding. Limited funds are available to cover children without MediCal insurance.

Mon - Thurs: 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Fri: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Spanish language services are available for monolingual families. Reasonable accommodations available upon request.
