The San Fernando Valley Community Mental Health Center's Older Adult Full Service Partnership Program provides a "whatever it takes" approach to deliver a wide variety of supportive services to the Older Adult population.

The program provides comprehensive services for individuals in their homes and communities. Services include:

- Mental Health Counseling
- Crisis Intervention
- Psychiatric Services

Other Supportive Services include:

- Housing Assistance
- Financial / Benefit Assistance
- Substance Abuse Treatment
- Basic Medical Support
- Peer Support
- Transportation



POPULATION SERVED:

The Program serves older adults 60 years of age or older who have a major mental health diagnosis and who are in need of intensive supportive services.

ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

One or more of the following criteria must be met in order to be considered for the Full Service Partnership Program:

- Homeless or imminent risk of homelessness
- Hospitalized or at risk of acute psychiatric hospitalizations
- Incarcerated or at risk of incarceration
- Imminent risk of placement at a skilled nursing facility or nursing home
- Presence of co-occurring disorder
- Recurring history or serious risk of abuse or self-neglect
- Serious risk of suicide
